B. Consideration of Amending Job Description for Accounting Clerk

Yvonne Russell, Town Clerk/Finance Officer explained that when asking about some technical procedures for the Accounting Clerk to be able to sign checks, she found out from the School of Government that they need to be designated as a Deputy Finance Officer to be able to legally sign checks. Ms. Russell said she asked if the Town could accomplish that with an amendment to the Accounting Clerk job description, and was told that would be sufficient.

**Ms. Russell** said item number one under 'Specific Duties, Functions, and Tasks' of the Accounting Clerk job description could be amended to read "Serves as Deputy Clerk for the purpose of counter signing checks or drafts issued".

**Mayor Paschal** asked if there were any questions. There were none. **Mayor Paschal** stated, "I make a **MOTION** to that effect."
